International workshop

“IMPACTS OF CLIMATE CHANGE – AIR POLLUTION ON CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES AND EDUCATION: FACTS AND INNOVATIONS”

Dear:

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Hanoi National University of Education and UNICEF Viet Nam co-organize an international workshop on “**Impacts of Climate Change – Air Pollution on Children with Disabilities and Education: Facts and Innovations**”, in collaboration with Wakayama University (Japan). The workshop will be held on 17th September 2021 (one day) at Hanoi National University of Education – Hanoi, Viet Nam.

1. Goals

The workshop serves as a forum for participants to exchange information, expertise and lessons learnt from national and international perspectives on the topic named “Impacts of Climate Change – Air Pollution on Children with Disabilities and Education: Facts and Innovations”.

Goals of the workshop are:

- a) To exchange national and international research findings of facts and impacts of climate change – air pollution on children with disabilities and education;
- b) To share ideas, innovations and lessons learnt from national and international perspectives on the application of technology to minimize the impacts of climate change and air pollution on the learning of children with disabilities; .
- c) To raise the awareness and participation of the community, education sector at all levels, particularly young persons with disabilities in preventing, reducing and responding to such impacts;
- d) To propose recommendations to the Ministry of Education and Training of Viet Nam and related stakeholders on policy directions to ensure the rights of children

with disabilities to quality education with an effective response plan, including in emergencies caused by climate change and/or air pollution.

2. Topics of Interest

The following key topics will be discussed during the workshop:

- a) Impacts of climate change – air pollution on children with disabilities and education: facts and challenges;
- b) Solutions and innovations in applying technology/IT to minimize the impacts of climate change and air pollution on the learning of children with disabilities;
- c) Initiatives for awareness raising and participation of the community, education sector at all levels, particularly young people with disabilities in preventing, reducing and responding to such impacts;
- d) Policies, programmes and supporting services for children with disabilities in the context of climate change, air pollution and pandemic, aiming to ensure the right to quality education for every child.

3. Papers and Presentations

(i) Papers

- a) Papers should be submitted by the deadline for a defense. Selected papers with good quality will be published on the Journal of Sciences – Hanoi National University of Education (ISSN 2354) or the Workshop Proceedings.
- b) Format:
 - Papers should be in the format of a research article of the Journal of Sciences – Hanoi National University of Education.
 - The text must not exceed 12 pages, typed in A4 size; font: Times New Roman 14, line spacing: before 6pt and after 0pt; margins: top and bottom 2.0 cm, left 3.0 cm, right 2.0 cm.
 - Languages: English and Vietnamese (title and abstract in both languages)
 - Papers should include the full name of author(s), professional titles, workplace, email and contact phone number.
 - References should be in the order of author(s) names, year of publication, title of book/paper, publisher, publishing address.
 - List of references should be sorted by the order of citation appearing in the paper from the beginning to the end.
 - A soft copy of the paper should be sent to the email address indicated in Part 5 of this announcement.

(ii) Oral Presentations

Oral presentations will be selected if they match with the workshop theme, and the author(s) will be informed directly in advance. In the COVID-19 context, oral presentations of international participants may be presented virtually.

(iii) Poster Presentation

Poster are designed by authors and they will be printed in A0 size by the organizers and exhibited in the workshop area.

(iv) Registration and Submission for papers

- Registration for papers should be completed by 23rd February 2021.
- Papers should be submitted by 01st June 2021.


